

Marriages: Marriages are celebrated in the Church where the bride or groom is registered at. When a man and a woman plan to marry each other, they should contact a priest one year in advance and always before the wedding date is set, and before arranging for the reception hall. The engaged are required to attend a Marriage Preparation Course.

Please note: However, if this man or woman has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted. Questions are often being asked about marriages performed outside the Catholic Church by non-Catholic ministers. These are not valid marriages according to the teaching of the Catholic Church, but many can be rectified by simply consulting with your Parish priest to discuss the available options. Sometimes people make decisions without proper information, so if you wish, please contact your Pastor for details or call the Marriage Tribunal at 416-934-3400 ext 300.

INVALID MARRIAGES

Whenever a marriage takes place in which one or both parties are Catholic, the Catholic party is bound by the required "form" for marriage. This "form" means that whenever a Catholic person is married, they are required to be married before a priest and two witnesses. This is a precept of the Church and all Catholics have a serious obligation to observe the required form. This is an essential part of being a Catholic Christian. Civil unions are contracts of marriage but are not recognized by the faith community as covenants or sacramental unions and therefore you cannot receive Holy Communion. Please contact Father if this is a situation you find yourself in and Father will be very happy to assist you.

COMMANDMENTS OF THE CHURCH

- To assist at Mass on all Sundays and holy days of obligation
- To fast and to abstain on the days appointed
- To confess your sins at least once a year
- To receive Holy Communion during the Easter season
- To contribute to the support of the Church
- To observe the laws so the Church concerning marriage

SAINT HILARY OF POITIERS, Bishop, Doctor of the Church 13 January

Born in Poitiers (France) about 315; died there on this day in 368. A married man with a family, he became a Christian and was elected bishop of his native city. Called the "Athanasius of the West" because of his strenuous defense of the divinity of Christ against the Arians, for which he was exiled by the emperor. Noted for his gentle, courteous and friendly nature, and for his contribution to the Western understanding of the Trinity.

SAINT ITA, Virgin 15 January

Ita was born in County Waterford of noble and Christian parents. Early on she set her mind on serving Christ in religious life. She founded a monastery in Killeedy, County Limerick, which attracted a variety of young people. She was given the title 'foster-mother of the saints of Ireland'. She died in 570.

SAINT FURSA, Abbot, Missionary 16 January

Fursa was born in Ireland and became one of the major monastic missionaries abroad. He went first with his brothers Foillan and Ultan to live the monastic life in East Anglia. But as large numbers continued to visit him there he left his brother Foillan as abbot, and sought refuge in France around 644. A patron gave him a hermitage at Lagny on the Marne. He died about 650 at Mezerolles while on a journey. His body was buried in Peronne, which became a centre of devotion to him.

ST ANTHONY. ABBOT 17 January

Born in 251 in upper Egypt; died in 356. At an early age he gave away his possessions and sought the austere life and solitude in the desert. Yet he remained involved in the theological controversies of his day, defending the divinity of Christ. He attracted disciples who formed communities of hermits. The account of his life by Saint Athanasius (2 May) was extremely influential in the development and spread of monasticism. Honoured as the father of western monasticism.

New parents are encouraged to consider naming their children after a Saint.
