

**Marriages:** Marriages are celebrated in the Church where the bride or groom is registered at. When a man and a woman plan to marry each other, they should contact a priest one year in advance and always before the wedding date is set, and before arranging for the reception hall. The engaged are required to attend a Marriage Preparation Course.

Please note: However, if this man or woman has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted. Questions are often being asked about marriages performed outside the Catholic Church by non-Catholic ministers. These are not valid marriages according to the teaching of the Catholic Church, but many can be rectified by simply consulting with your Parish priest to discuss the available options. Sometimes people make decisions without proper information, so if you wish, please contact your Pastor for details or call the Marriage Tribunal at 416-934-3400 ext 300.

#### **INVALID MARRIAGES**

Whenever a marriage takes place in which one or both parties are Catholic, the Catholic party is bound by the required "form" for marriage. This "form" means that whenever a Catholic person is married, they are required to be married before a priest and two witnesses. This is a precept of the Church and all Catholics have a serious obligation to observe the required form. This is an essential part of being a Catholic Christian. Civil unions are contracts of marriage but are not recognized by the faith community as covenants or sacramental unions. Please contact Father if this is a situation you find yourself in and Father will be very happy to assist you. (For those married outside the church e.g. Las Vegas, garden/backyard or Town halls, during Holy Communion ask for a Blessing.)

## DO FRANKINSCENSE and MYRRH CHASE AWAY EVIL?

We all know where we encounter incense, at least sometimes: there are priests, bishops, and cardinals — as well as the Pope — who use frankincense or myrrh or both resins in sacramental censers. Just thinking of it, one can almost smell the lofty aroma.

It certainly brings a certain gravity to Mass (and yet, with that gravity, elevation). Were the herbs so treasured, by wise men, and by royalty, because the plants had spiritual as well as temporal value?

This goes deep into history. We can cite Genesis (37:25): "Then they sat down to eat a meal. And as they raised their eyes and looked, behold, a caravan of Ishmaelites was coming from Gilead, with their camels bearing aromatic gum and balm and myrrh, on their way to bring them down to Egypt."

Myrrh has been used for millennia as incense and medicine: mixed with posca (wine, vinegar, and water) or wine alone, it was common across ancient cultures for general pleasure, probably bartering, and as a painkiller.

You can go back to the fifth dynasty ruler in Egypt (King Sahure): Egyptians brought myrrh in large quantities from the Horn of Africa (especially Somalia). Some believed it had rare properties.

It makes appearances from the beginning of Jesus' mission on earth to the end. Along with Christ, Who came into the world specifically to break the strongholds of evil, perhaps there is symbology in the role of those resins right there at the start, at the manger.

Note (Matthew 2:11) that they fell to their knees, paying homage to Him with their gifts.

It was there to the end. At the Crucifixion (Mark 15:23), "They tried to give Him wine mixed with myrrh" (but He did not take it).

Of course, most famous is Matthew 2:11: "After coming into the house they saw the Child with Mary His mother; and they fell to the ground and worshiped Him. Then, opening their treasures, they presented to Him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh."

In some translations, John 19:39 says, "Joseph [of Arimathea] and Nicodemus took the body and bound it in linen cloths with the spices (myrrh and aloes)."

Now, what about frankincense? "Use myrrh with frankincense to put a whammy on bad spirits and demons," says a secular site, focusing on the supernatural.

Can we put any trust in that? Aren't we called through life to purify, as Mary was immaculate, preparing for Heaven?

No smoke clears demons unless it is blessed by a priest, and nothing clears spirits like the Name "Jesus," smoke or not. -Spirit Daily

#### **CONVERSION OF ST. PAUL, Apostle, January 25**

St. Paul, the Apostle of the Gentiles, was born in Tarsus, Turkey, of observant Jewish parents. He was a Roman citizen from birth. To complete his studies, he went to the school of Gamaliel in Jerusalem and was educated in the strict observance of the Pharisees. His zeal for the Jewish Law led him to support the stoning of St. Stephen and to persecute the Christian Church, holding it to be a heretic sect. Entrusted with a formal mission from the high priest, Saul departed to Damascus to arrest the Christians and to bring them to Jerusalem. As he was nearing Damascus, about noon, a light from the sky suddenly flashed around him. He fell to the ground and heard a voice saying: Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me? He said: Who are you, Sir? The reply came: I am the Jesus, whom you are persecuting. Now get up and go to the city and you will be told what you must do (acts 9:4-6). The men who were traveling with him stood speechless, for they heard the voice but could see no one. When he got up he was blind and was brought to the city. Three days later, a certain Ananias entered the house, laid his hands on him, and said: Brother Saul, I have been sent by the Lord Jesus so that you may recover your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit (Acts 9:18). Then he was baptized.

#### Prayer to St. Paul the Apostle

O Glorious St. Paul, after persecuting the Church you became by God's grace its most zealous Apostle. To carry the knowledge of Jesus, our Divine Savior, to the uttermost parts of the earth, you joyfully endured prison, scourging, stoning, and shipwreck, as well as all manner of persecutions culminating in the shedding of the last drop of your blood for our Lord Jesus Christ. Obtain for us the grace to labor strenuously to bring the faith to others and to accept any trials and tribulations that may come our way. Help us to be inspired by your Epistles and to partake of your indomitable love for Jesus, so that after we have finished our course we may join you in praising Him in Heaven for all eternity. Amen.
