As we are during Lent now, let us reflect the suggestions given by our Holy Father Francis during his last eleven years of his Pontificate to prepare ourselves to receive the new life that Jesus wants to offer at Easter this year.

### **REMEMBER THAT CHRIST'S POVERTY**

**ENRICHES US:** "God becoming man is a great mystery," but it was done out of "a love which is grace, generosity, ... a love which does not hesitate to offer itself in sacrifice for the beloved."

### FIGHT THE "GLOBALIZATION OF INDIFFERENCE" INDIVIDUALLY AND COLLECTIVELY: "Indifference to our neighbor and

to God ... represents a real temptation for us

Christians. Each year during Lent we need to hear once more the voice of the prophets who cry out and trouble our conscience."

### GOD'S "BOUNDLESS" MERCY CAN HELP US BE MERCIFUL IN TURN: "God's mercy

transforms human hearts; it enables us, through the experience of a faithful love, to become merciful in turn," through corporal works and spiritual works of mercy.

# THE IMPORTANCE OF SPENDING TIME

**WITH THE WORD OF GOD:** "Lent is a favorable season for deepening our spiritual life through 'fasting, prayer, and almsgiving'. At the basis of everything is the word of God, that during this season, we are invited to hear and ponder more deeply."

### BEWARE OF INIQUITY AND FIGHT IT WITH PRAYER, ALMSGIVING, AND FASTING:

"Because of the increase of iniquity, the love of many will grow cold" (Mt. 24:12). "The soothing remedy of prayer, almsgiving, and fasting," which helps "take up the Lenten journey with enthusiasm."

### **REMEMBER THE REDEMPTION OF**

**CREATION:** "This mystery of salvation, already at work in us during our earthly lives, is a dynamic process that also embraces history and all of creation." Pope thus warned against "the destructive power of sin" and called that the "desert of creation" be "once more the garden of communion with God that it was before original sin."

**LENT IS A PERIOD FOR CONVERSION:** Lent is always a "favorable time for our conversion," which "should never be taken for granted."

**RENEWING OUR FAITH, HOPE AND LOVE AS WE PREPARE FOR EASTER:** "During this season of conversion, let us renew our faith, draw from the "living water" of hope, and receive with open hearts the love of God, who makes us brothers and sisters in Christ,"

**LET US NOT GROW TIRED OF DOING GOOD**: Pope cited three ways to show goodness: "not grow tired of praying," "not grow tired of uprooting evil from our lives," and "not grow tired of doing good in active charity towards our neighbors."

**LENT AS A MOMENT OF ASCENSION AND TRANSFIGURATION:** "During Lent we are invited to ascend "a high mountain" in the company of Jesus and to live a particular experience of spiritual discipline – ascesis – as God's holy people," Pope Francis encouraged us to "listen to Jesus" by attending the liturgy and studying the Bible
