#### Dear brothers and sisters,

I heard once a beautiful reflection from a Bishop in the Philippines who explained the meaning of Lent. I felt that it is appropriate and an excellent way to look at Lent. I would like to share with you his thoughts this week.

- 1. Lent means "Spring" in the German language. Spring is the time the trees bloom, the flowers come out, the whole nature refresh. Similarly, it is the time for human souls to bloom, to flourish, to refresh, and to reinstate the grace of baptism.
- 2. Lent means "Slow" in Latin. It is the time to slow down from rapid lifestyle, to take time to pray, reflect, and meditate, and to prepare ourselves for the eternal life.
- 3. Lent in English is the past tense for "Lend". God lent us life, and many more unbelievable things in our lives. We borrowed from Him everything. One day we are accountable to God for all what we received or borrowed from Him. Therefore, during this time of Lent, let us allow ourselves to spring the soul, let us slow down from all the activities, and give priority to our life eternal, and let us prepare ourselves to give back to the lender all what we borrowed from Him

#### Consecration to Mary March 6th



To consecrate means to dedicate. It is used in reference to worship and means to be set aside or set apart for God. It is also a word which speaks to the very core

of the Christian vocation. We are all called through our Baptism to be set aside for God.

The 33 day consecration begins on **March 6**<sup>th</sup> with the consecration date of April 8<sup>th</sup> on the Feast of the Annunciation. The Feast was moved out by the Church because March 25<sup>th</sup> is within Holy Week this year.

Once you make the consecration, it is for life. It can then be renewed annually. Keep in mind that this is a formal consecration to Our Lady, not unlike a vow, that is to be done in a solemn manner. Through this 33-day program you are giving Mary all of yourself - heart, mind, and soul - in order to bring you to her Son, Jesus Christ. Also that she may use you as a holy instrument in her battle with Satan - i.e. this consecration allows her the free reign in your life to make you holy (as she assists you, through the Holy Spirit, to conform to her virtues) and to use your prayers, sacrifices, and sufferings for the greater glory of God.
