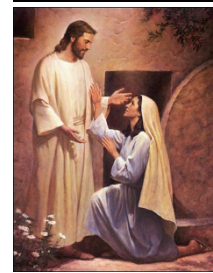
Sutton Fence Installation

Dalton Road. Work will begin the week of July 22, 2024 and take about six weeks.

July 22: The Feast of Saint Mary Magdalene



+ Mary of Magdala features prominently in all four gospels and she is most especially celebrated for her fidelity to Jesus during his Passion.

+ The Gospel of John highlights her importance when it describes her as going to Jesus' tomb alone and discovering that the body of the Lord is missing. In tears, she says to the angels at the tomb, "They have taken my Lord away and I do not know where they have put him" (20:1-18). Moments later, Jesus appeared to her, making her the first witness of the Resurrection.

+ Various legends grew up around Mary Magdalene, including the unfounded assumption that she was a reformed prostitute. Today, she is honoured as a patron saint of contemplative nuns.

+ In 2016, Pope Francis elevated the liturgical celebration of Saint Mary Magdalene to the rank of "Feast," making her liturgical celebration equal to that of the other Apostles. *Aleteia*

July 25: The Feast of St. James, Major

James, the brother of John the Evangelist, was the first Apostle to be martyred. He was beheaded by order of Herod of Agrippa. The Gospels tell us that the two brothers left their father, Zebedee, and followed Jesus as soon as He called out to them.



James was one of the three Apostles who were particularly close to the Lord. He was there with the Lord and his brother, John, and Peter at the Transfiguration and in the Garden of Gethsemane.

He is known as James "the Greater" to distinguish him from the other Apostle by the same name. The title has little to do with his function or the people's regard for him; rather, it was a term indicating that he was the elder of the two. He is the patron saint of Spain and of pilgrims. In northwestern Spain, he is venerated at Santiago de Compostela, a mediaeval pilgrimage site that is still very popular today. *CNA*

FROM THE IJEBU-ODE DIOCESE, NIGERIA MISSION APPEAL

At the weekend liturgies of **July 27/28, 2024**, **Fr. Augustine Adetola**, a diocesan priest from Ijebu-Ode diocese, Nigeria, will be here to speak about the missionary work currently going on in the Catholic Diocese of Ijebu-Ode, Nigeria. Fr. Augustine is currently the Mission Coordinator for the Catholic Diocese of Ijebu-Ode in the USA and Canada and doubles as the Parochial Vicar at St. Peter Claver Parish in Houston, Texas. He has a vast knowledge of the rural area of the diocese, having played different roles in the affairs of the diocese for many years.

The Catholic Diocese of Ijebu-Ode is in Ogun State, the Western part of Nigeria, near Lagos. Ijebu-Ode diocese is a mission diocese. Her population is predominantly Muslim; 50% Muslims, 25% Christians of other denominations, 15% Catholics and 10% Traditional African believers. The diocese has 45 parishes with over 150 churches, 7 houses of formation and 12 religious houses for male and female religious groups. The Catholic population does not have enough material and financial resources to sustain her many developing programs of evangelization; sustenance of over 70 priests and 90 religious, training of 36 seminarians for the priesthood, and sustaining primary health care project, for the villagers.

Our primary concern as a diocese is to spread the good news to all the nooks and crannies of the diocese through building schools, churches, training priests and religious and providing quality healthcare for the population. Your donation this year will help us to provide tuition fees for over 300 children in our Catholic schools, train 25 seminarians to become priests, build 5 deep wells in rural communities without water and help us give over 500 children Malaria vaccines. The help and support of many generous people from all over the world makes it possible to continue God's work in the missions. Your own efforts to support the Missions all over the world are greatly appreciated. **Know that when you give to the Missions, you give to a good cause.**
