The Solemnity of Christ the King of the Universe

November 24, 2024 The Liturgical Year Ends.



The Solemnity of Christ the King is the final Sunday of the liturgical calendar – the last Sunday of Ordinary Time. The season of Advent

begins the following Sunday. In the Catholic Church, it is a Solemnity and a Holy Day of Obligation and priests wear white.

The purpose of this feast is to draw our minds and hearts closer to acknowledging the authority and sovereignty of Christ in a society that often forgets or denies His power and kingship. The reign of Christ does not refer to an earthly power but a divine one. There are many references to Christ as King in the Bible. In Revelation (19:16), Jesus is referred to as "King of Kings and Lord of Lords."


In John 18:33, 36-37, the divine authority of Christ is made clear: [Pilate] said to [Jesus], "Are you the King of the Jews?" ... Jesus answered, "My kingdom does not belong to this world." ... So Pilate said to Him, "Then you are a king?" Jesus answered, "You say I am a king. For this I was born and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth."

The purpose of this solemnity is best expressed in the words of Pope Pius XI:

"When once men recognize, both in private and in public life, that Christ is King, society will at last receive the great blessings of real liberty, well-ordered discipline, peace, and harmony." My Catholic Kids

St. Andrew Feast November 30

Patron Saint of Fishermen St. Andrew was one of the Twelve Apostles and brother to St. Peter. Born in the village of Bethsaida on the Sea of Galilee, Andrew was one of the first disciples of Jesus. Per Christian



tradition, he went on to preach the Gospel in the region that is now Greece and Turkey. He was martyred by crucifixion in Patras; it is believed that he requested that his cross be made in the shape of an X because he thought he was unworthy to be killed on the same style of cross that Jesus had died upon. Andrew is the patron saint of fishermen because of his shared profession with his brother. Pope Benedict XVI called Andrew the "Apostle of the Greek world" and called on imagery of brotherhood between Peter and Andrew and Western and Eastern Churches.




