## Ordinandi 2025

Ordination is the sacramental ceremony in which a man becomes a deacon, priest, or bishop and is enabled to minister in the name of Christ and the Church. There are

three ordinations in the Sacrament of Holy Orders: diaconate (for deacons), presbyteral (for priests), and episcopal (for bishops).

The Ordinandi Dinner honours the transitional deacons who study, pray and reside at St. Augustine's Seminary and at Redemptoris Mater Seminary. With God's grace, these men will be ordained to the priesthood.

This is a time for the Roman Catholic community in the Archdiocese of Toronto to come together with their families and friends to celebrate new vocations to the priesthood and religious life amidst good fellowship and good food.

## **Ordinandi Spiritual bouquet**

A Spiritual bouquet is an offering of Masses, Communions, Rosaries, Stations of the Cross, Eucharistic Adorations, Sacrifices, Visits to the Blessed Sacrament, Novenas and other forms of prayers offered for the



Seminarians who will be ordained Priests and will take their vows in 2025. These offerings are not paid offerings. You can offer as many Masses as possible: Communions, Rosaries, etc. It can be Masses you attend during the week or on Sunday and can be offered with other intentions. There is no time limit. You may start anytime. And it can be completed over the next year.

The Ordinandi of 2024 were very appreciative of the many hundreds of thousands of prayers they received. Each Candidate is given a framed certificate to keep, showing the number of prayers they received from our Catholic community.
