Palm Sunday, April 13, 2025

There is both great joy and terrible sorrow associated with this day, the Sunday that begins Holy Week, the Sunday that

portends the crucifixion of Our Lord.

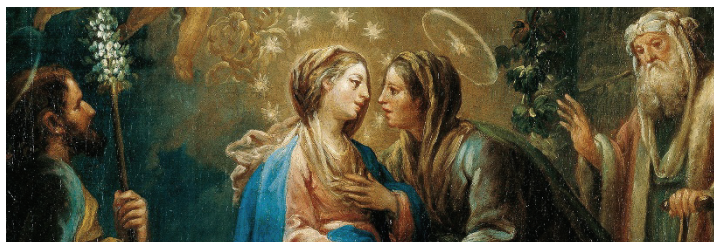
On Palm Sunday Year C (Passion Sunday), we reflect on the sentencing of Jesus and His journey to the cross. This reflection helps us understand the depth of Jesus' love and sacrifice. As we read the scripture and imagine ourselves in the scene, we are challenged to consider how we would respond if we were there. Jesus faced false accusations and remained silent, showing His trust in God's plan.

The very people who applaud Christ's entrance into Jerusalem that morning, shouting out "Hosanna" and words of adoration will, within a week, be crying, "Crucify Him." They will go from acclaiming Him as the new King of Israel to urging His life be traded in favor of a convicted criminal; they will first praise Him and then mock Him. Even friends entering Jerusalem at His side will desert Jesus. All this discord will take place during one week beginning on what we call Palm Sunday.

When we feel powerless or afraid, we can remember that Jesus invites us to be with Him in His suffering, giving us the strength to face our own challenges. It is a time of despair, perplexity and contradiction.

A Day with Mary 2025

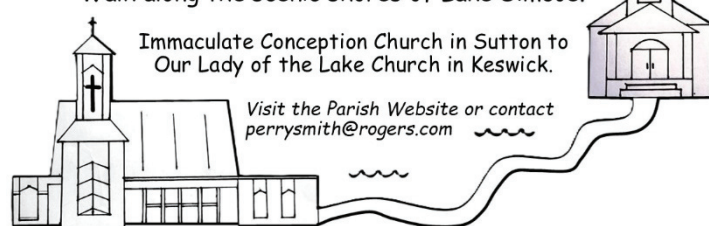
