Palm Sunday

Palm Sunday is the final Sunday of Lent, the beginning of Holy Week, and commemorates the triumphant arrival of Christ in Jerusalem, days before He was crucified. Palm Sunday is known as such because the faithful will often receive palm fronds which they use to participate in the reenactment of Christ's arrival in Jerusalem. In the Gospels, Jesus entered Jerusalem riding a young donkey, and to the lavish praise of the townspeople who threw clothes, or possibly palms or small branches, in front of him as a sign of homage. This was a customary practice for people of great respect. Palm branches are widely recognized as symbols of peace and victory, hence their preferred use on Palm Sunday. The use of a donkey instead of a horse is highly symbolic; it represents the humble arrival of someone in peace, as opposed to arriving on a steed in war. A week later, Christ would rise from the dead on the first Easter. During Palm Sunday Mass, palms are distributed to parishioners who carry them in a ritual procession into church. The palms are blessed and many people will fashion them into small crosses or other items of personal devotion. These may be returned to the church or kept for the year. Because the palms are blessed, they may not be discarded as trash. Instead, they are appropriately gathered at the church and incinerated to create the ashes that will be used in the follow year's Ash Wednesday observance. The colours of the Mass on Palm Sunday are red and white, symbolizing the redemption in blood that Christ paid for the world. *Catholic Online*

Chrism Mass

The Mass of Chrism is a special Mass held in Toronto at St. Michael’s Cathedral for the priests of the Archdiocese of Toronto on the Tuesday of Holy Week at 11:00am. At the Chrism Mass, the holy oils used in the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Orders and Sacrament of the Sick are blessed and supplied to the local parishes for use.

The Chrism Mass is one of the most beautiful and important liturgies of Holy Week. It takes place in the cathedral and is celebrated by the bishop, together with priests, deacons, religious, and lay faithful from across the diocese. Here’s what makes it special:

1. The Blessing of the Holy Oils

During the Chrism Mass, the bishop blesses three sacred oils that will be used in every parish throughout the year. These oils are then taken back to each parish as a sign of unity with the bishop and the wider diocesan Church.

2. Renewal of Priestly Promises

All priests gather with the bishop to renew the promises they made at their ordination - committing again to faithful service, prayer, and pastoral care of God’s people.

3. A Celebration of Unity

The Chrism Mass highlights that we are one Church, united in mission.

HOLY WEEK



Holy Week is the week which precedes the great Feast of the Resurrection on Easter Sunday: it includes the last days of

Lent and the beginning of the Easter Triduum. During Holy Week, the Church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of His life on earth, beginning with His messianic entrance into Jerusalem.

The Sacred Paschal Triduum

Through his Paschal Mystery, the Lord Jesus redeemed the human race and gave perfect glory to the Father. By dying, Christ destroyed our death; by rising, he restored our life. For this reason, the Easter Triduum, when we celebrate the suffering, Death and Resurrection of our Lord, is the high point of the Liturgical Year. The Easter Solemnity is to the year what Sunday is to the week. The celebration of the Easter Triduum opens with the evening Mass of the Lord’s Supper, reaches its climax in the Easter Vigil, and closes with Evening Prayer II on Easter Sunday. (GNLY, nos. 18-19)
