Feast of St. Bartholomew, August 24



St. Bartholomew, a doctor in the Jewish law, was a dear friend of St. Philip the Apostle. Because Bartholomew was a man "in whom there was no guile," his mind was open to the truth. He went willingly with Philip to see Christ, and recognized the Saviour immediately as the Son of God. After having received the gifts of the Holy Spirit on the first Pentecost, Bartholomew evangelized Asia Minor, northwestern India, and Greater Armenia. In the latter country, while preaching to idolaters, he was arrested and condemned to death.

Historically, today is the feast of Our Lady, Health of the Sick. *Catholic Culture*

The initiation of new members is a gradual process allowing catechumens time to grow in faith and become full participants of the Catholic community. Bring a friend and come be a part of this beautiful celebration of Christ the King, faith and fellowship!

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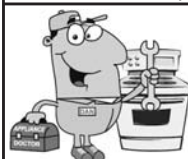


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
