The Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, September 8



Only three birthdays are celebrated on the Church's liturgical calendar; the Nativity of Our Lord (December 25), the Nativity of His Forerunner, John the Baptist (June 24), and the Nativity of His Mother on September 8. Thus, the Church uniquely honours the three principal figures connected to the Incarnation and Redemption. Mary's birth lies at the confluence of the two Testaments – bringing to an end the stage of expectation and the promises and inaugurating the era of grace and salvation in Jesus Christ. The birth of Mary is ordained in particular towards her mission as Mother of the Saviour. Her existence is indissolubly connected with that of Christ: it partakes of a unique plan of predestination and grace. God's mysterious plan regarding the Incarnation of the Word embraces also the Virgin who is His Mother. In this way, the Birth of Mary, as her Divine Child, is inserted at the very heart of the History of Salvation. *EWTN*

Prayer: Dearest Mother Mary, your conception was immaculate and your birth glorious. You were conceived without sin, born without sin, and remained sinless throughout your life. In Heaven, you radiate the beauty and splendour of God and will do so for all eternity. Please pray for me, that I will more fully imitate your many virtues, so that I can be a fitting instrument of your divine Son in the world. Mother Mary, pray for me. Jesus, I trust in You.

R.C.I.A. stands for the **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**. It is a process of Christian formation offered to those who seek to become Catholic. The initiation of new members is a gradual process allowing catechumens time to grow in faith and become full participants of the Catholic community. There are several stages and ritual steps, leading up to the reception of all three Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.
