Sunday Mass Obligation

On March 13, 2020, Cardinal Collins issued a communication to the faithful indicating that it was necessary to cancel public celebrations of the Eucharist on the coming Sunday, stating: "For this weekend and any other which may be required, I grant the faithful dispensation from their Sunday obligation".

Given that most of the health and safety restrictions in our parishes are no longer in place and the faithful are able to attend the celebration of the Eucharist once again, the basis for the **dispensation from the Sunday obligation has dissipated and is no longer in effect.**

The Church does not obligate people to do the impossible. If individuals, based on their conscience, cannot attend Mass for a grave reason, including a great vulnerability to COVID-19 or because they are self-isolating to limit the spread of illness, then they are excused from their Sunday obligation, as the law of the Church allows. We invite and encourage the faithful **to return to the practice of attending Mass in-person.**
